


# “It’s A Brand New Day.”


# The Civic Club

# 1899

The Civic Club purchased 26 trash receptacles for downtown Harrisburg and urged City Council to pass a resolution making littering and offense.

# 1908

At the urging of the Civic Club, dumping trash and garbage on the riverbank was prohibited by City Council and garbage collection was started.

# 1914-1918

In WWI Overlook was used daily for Red Cross work for military hospitals and for entertaining servicemembers (USO).

# 1923

The first three kindergarten was established in Harrisburg with The Civic Club of Harrisburg paying the teacher's salary.

# 1972


As an Arbor Day project, The Civic Club of Harrisburg began planting trees in Riverfront Park honoring club members and outstanding community volunteers.

# 2011

TCCH launched its civic-minded breakfast programs for nonprofit service organizations to encourage information sharing and program collaboration.


Our scholarship program is available to assist students in any Dauphin County based school district. We raise funds for students through our Hershey Park Volunteer Program.
