






"WOMEN'S HISTORY GARDEN PROJECT"

1899

The Civic Club purchased 26 trash receptacles for downtown Harrisburg and urged City Council to pass a resolution making littering and offense.

1923

The first three kindergarten was established in Harrisburg with The Civic Club of Harrisburg paying the teacher's salary.

1908

At the urging of the Civic Club, dumping trash and garbage on the riverbank was prohibited by City Council and garbage collection was started.

1972

As an Arbor Day project, The Civic Club of Harrisburg began planting trees in Riverfront Park honoring club members and outstanding community volunteers.


COMMUNITY PROGRAMS: 3rd in the Burg

COMMUNITY PROGRAMS: Art Walks & City Events




We host art walks to coincide with city events, like Kipona.


SERVICE OUTREACH: SCHOLARSHIPS
